The rain may collect on the streets and even in houses. This is called a flood.



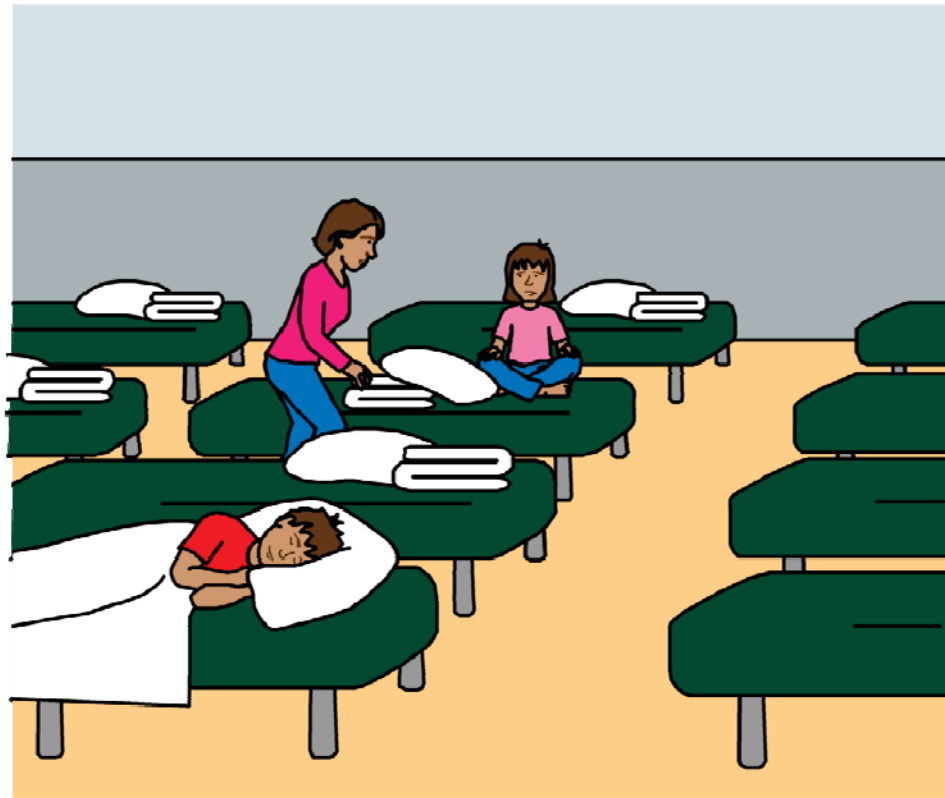
Some people lose power during the hurricane.

If my house loses power, I can read, draw, or play with toys until the power comes back on.



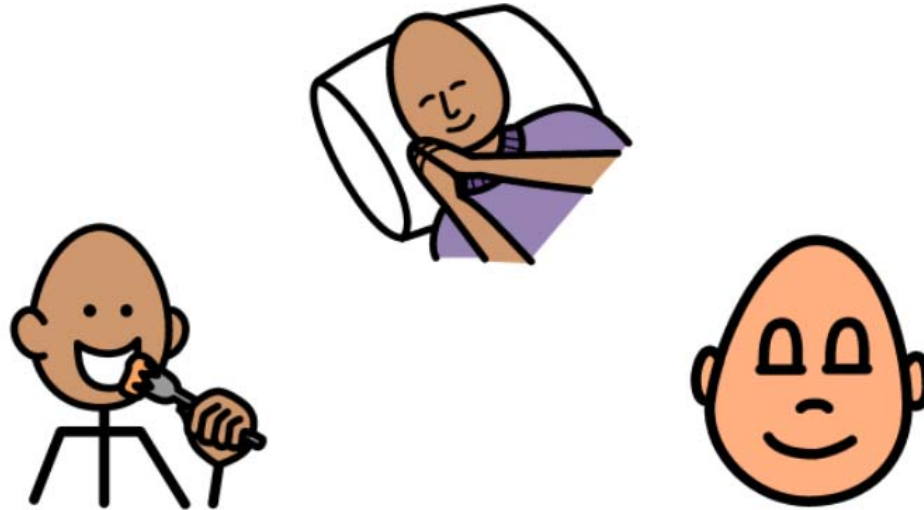
If there is rain in my house, I may need to go somewhere that is safe and dry.



I will stay in my house until an adult tells me it is safe to leave.



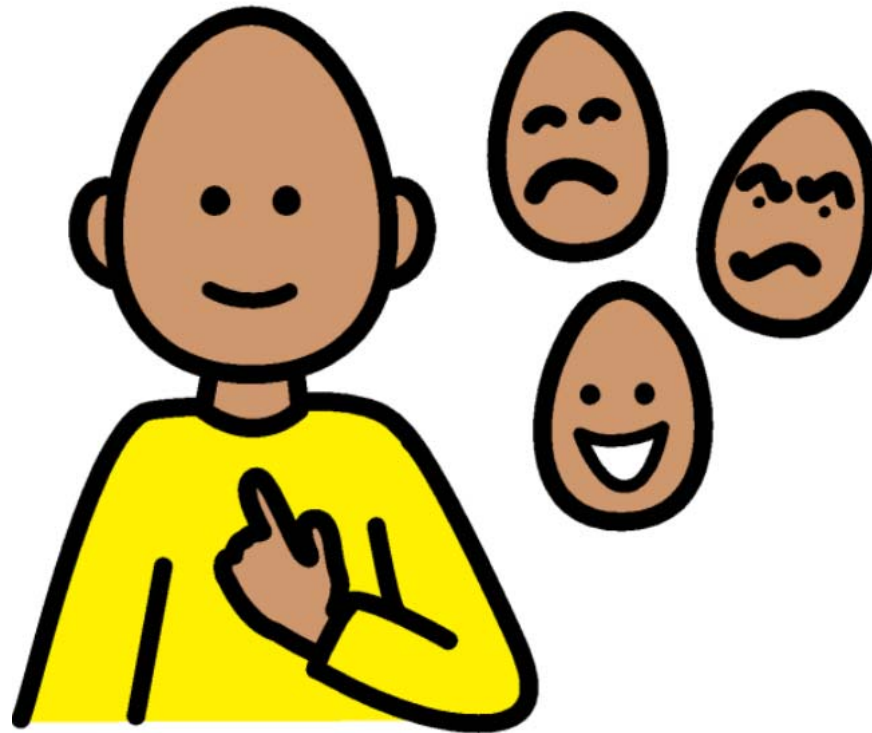
I will be able to eat, sleep, and stay safe in the new place.



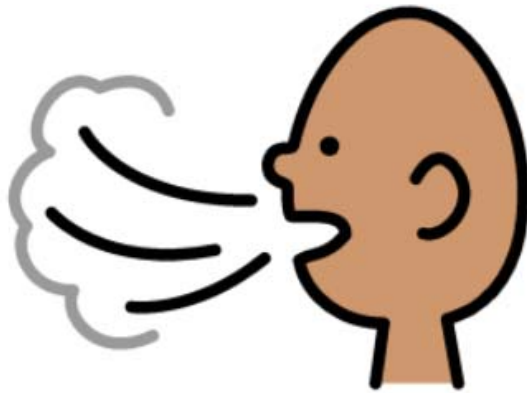
I will follow adult directions to stay safe.



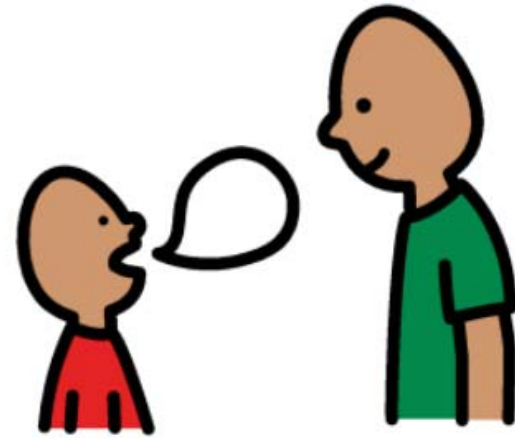
It's ok to feel scared or sad during the flood.



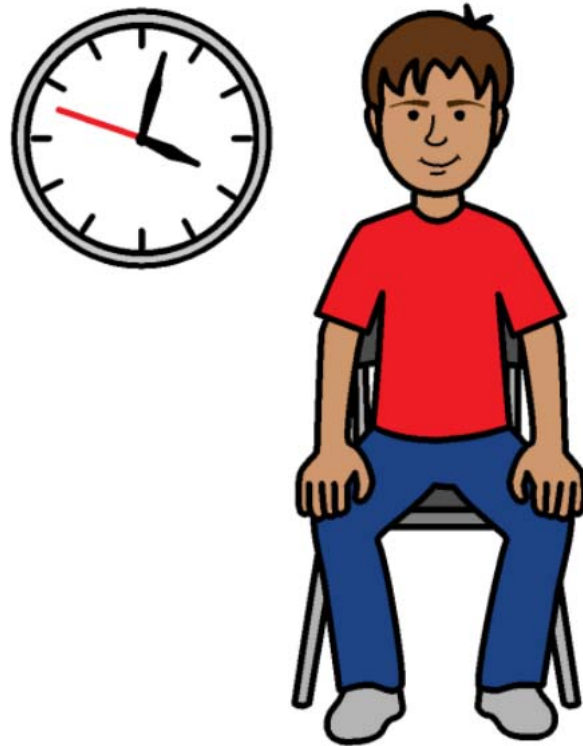
I can take deep breaths or talk to my family to feel better.
